

Vancouver is a very busy Cruise Ship destination. Book your flights as early as possible. Keep this pamphlet with you as you travel for easy access to all our important telephone numbers.

Flight Information



We will depart with **Northern Thunderbird Air** from the ESSO AVITAT at South Terminal at 9 am

We will serve you lunch at Brady's Bistro in the Sandspit Airport and travel via Helijet approximately a 30 minute Sikorsky flight to the Charlotte Oueen.

A Charlotte Queen Representative will greet you and give you a fishing information kit.

Return Flight to Vancouver Departure: between 3:00 and 4:00pm Arrival: between 5:00 and 6:00pm. This schedule is dependent on weather and fish loads.

What to Pack

Pack Light (Under 25 Pounds Please) Maximum 25lbs. per person. This becomes critical on the return flight when you are loaded with your catch. Use of a soft-sided bag is preferred as they pack much better on the planes. Taking your bag aboard the plane as carry-on will save you money on any return flights from Vancouver to home.

Don't forget, you will be returning with 1, 2 or more 50 pound airline approved boxes of dressed fish.

Clothing We provide Mustang suits and rubber boots for best fishing outerwear, but do bring non-slip shoes, a windbreaker, sweatshirts or sweaters, extra pants and shorts. Please include warm socks, gloves, sun screen, sunglasses and a swimsuit for the hot tub.

Personal Item Forget your toothbrush and shaving kit if you wish, but don't forget your camera. The scenery is nothing short of spectacular. Carry any important medications with you.

Important Information! We strongly recommend that you plan to spend the night of your departure from the ship in Richmond! If you must travel, DO NOT BOOK A FLIGHT PRIOR TO 8:00pm.

Medications

Please ensure you have a full supply of any prescribed medications you require and include them in your carry-on luggage. There is a limited supply of over-the-counter medications aboard the ship

Passports

Guests Flying and Driving from USA require passports. It is mandatory that passports must be presented at time of border crossing and or PACIFIC COASTAL AIRLINES check in. Guests driving across the border may still use other picture ID, but we recommend passports.

Your Catch

We clean, vacuum pack and freeze your catch with care. Everything possible is done to ensure your catch reaches your destination just the way you like it.

If you would like to have your fish canned or smoked, just advise the dock crew and they will make sure it gets to St. Jean's Cannery on Vancouver Island. More details on this will be provided on the ship.

Meals and Beverages

We will feed you from before daybreak until bedtime. Beer and wine are complimentary with your meals.

If you have a favourite liquor, we suggest you bring it with you.

Fishing starts early and our chefs prepare a changing hot buffet breakfast to get you going.

You may return to the ship for a hot buffet lunch from 11:30-1:30 PM or take a lunch with you and fish until you drop.

Dinner is scheduled around the tides but usually is around 8 PM.

Of course, bottled water, juice and soft drinks and other light beverages are always available.

Special Note:

For those who may suffer periodic "sea sickness" we suggest you take motion sickness medication the night prior to your departure to the ship and then again in the morning. This allows the medication to get into your system, hence a more comfortable first afternoon.
